The [What Works Clearing House](#) found strong evidence that engaging students by offering curricula and programming that connect school work with college and career success improves students' capacity to **manage challenges in and out of school**. Our goal is to teach adaptive leadership skills to students in order to grow their capacity as empowered activists and align their personal interest with opportunities for direct community impact



Action Impact Project

Fellowship experiences should lead to outcomes. Our Youth of Promise Fellows identify an area of opportunity in their education or community ecosystem and create an action plan to address the identified needs. This experience leads to tangible outcomes where students can SEE and feel their impact. Our fellows become youth capable of identifying needs and devising plans of action.



Evaluation & Self-Reflection

At the end of the 10-week fellowship, students will have an opportunity to evaluate their progress measured against their goals. Youth will also engage in peer feedback using the 2x2 feedback framework. While action projects are not expected to be fully completed, students will be deeply engaged in a school or community-based project that is highly likely to produce positive outcomes for school or community.
